

## What can you do at home?

- **Go on a local walk.** What can you hear and see?
- **Draw a map of your walk or route to school.**
- **Use Google Earth together to find your house.**
- **Learn your own address.**
- **Play a throwing and catching game.** Start with a large ball and change to a smaller ball as your child becomes more confident.
- **Write a shopping list.** What letter sound can you hear at the beginning of words?
- **Visit the shop together and let your child pay.** What coins do you need? Can you count the coins?
- **Read books about transport and vehicles.** Can you find out facts about hot air balloons or hovercraft?
- **Did you know?**... Between 3 and 5 children should have a vocabulary of at least 5000 to 8000 words. Keep talking and introduce new words all the time.

- develop an understanding of how we change over time
- complete simple ICT programs

- recognise numbers to 10
- match the correct number of objects to numbers up to 10
- say the number that is 1 more when counting objects
- find the total of 2 groups by counting all of them
- use everyday language related to money

## EAD

- create vehicles using junk modelling resources

- engage in role play e.g. on a pretend bus, looking after babies etc.
- use simple tools well

## PD

- prepare for Sports Day
- practise throwing and catching skills
- travel with confidence on balancing equipment
- hold a pencil correctly and with control
- understand the need for safety when using tools
