Remember the more you read the better you get!


Class DOJO:

Spring 1 - 2019

Talk for Writing

This term we are looking at writing a recount about a local visit. We will explore the correct language to recount what we did. This will lead to writing a postcard home. We will also explore the story of Mr Gumpy's Outing by John Burningham.



Science

Our Science topic is Human Body and Animals. We will look at different animal families such as reptiles, birds and mammals. They will explore the 5 human senses and label parts of the body.



General Knowledge

The pupils will explore life skills, we will explore and practice different life skills through the term.

RE

The pupils will look at the Bible. We will explore this special book for Christians. Looking at the Creation story and Moses.

RWI - Reading

Children will work in their RWI groups so they are being challenged at the right level. They will continue to learn or review a sound every day and practise blending sounds to read words. This is the most crucial skill in Year 1 as at the end of Year 1 (June 2019) they will sit a reading check to ensure they are on track.



PE

PE is taught every Tuesday and Friday. Our Summer topic continues to be Athletics

Effective Maths

We will be focussing on Money, Direction and Position and Place Value. The children will use their shape skills to turn and draw shapes. They will practice counting up in 2's, 5's and 10's and talk about the value of each digit in a 2 digit number. Each Friday we will complete our Number Bonds Quiz.



Jigsaw

We will be exploring Dreams and Goals. We will set ourselves aspirational goals and look how these can be met by hard work and effort. We will continue developing our teamwork skills and working collaboratively.



History

We will be exploring Prehistoric Britain through such topics as Stonehenge, the Ice Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age. The children will learn about life in Britain before records began and compare it to life now.
