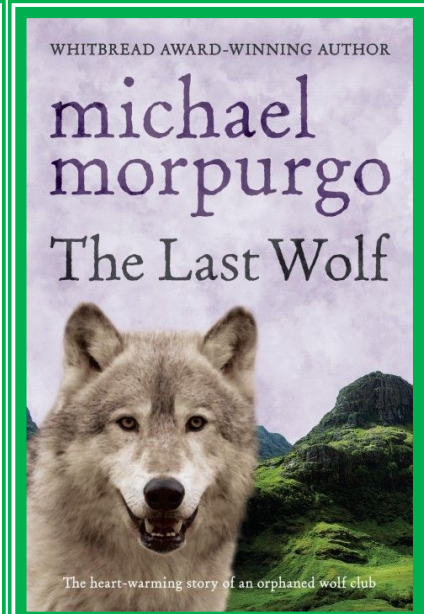

Autumn 2 has been a great term and the children have worked well across both classes. We hope that their commitment to learning continues.

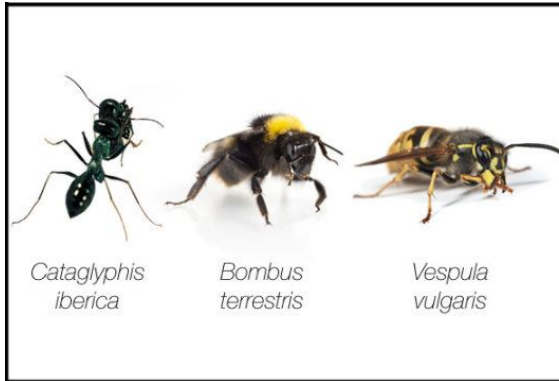
Effective Maths

Children will build on their knowledge gained in term 2, and will learn about geometry, money and decimals, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division, place value and fractions. Please continue to support your child with multiplication and division facts 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10.

Core Knowledge Curriculum

The children will be exploring Ancient Greece, with a focus on the features of the the culture of the civilisation and impacts on modern life.

In Science they will be investigating insects, particularly social insects like bees and ants.
