Effective Maths


Children will build on their knowledge gained in term 1, and will learn about time, fractions, multiplication and division, percentages and geometry. Please continue to support your child with multiplication and division facts 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10.

Core Knowledge Curriculum

We will be exploring Rivers of the world, with a focus on the features and impacts of the main rivers in each continent of the world, and how these rivers are used by their communities.

In Science they will be investigating and experimenting with simple machines, discovering how they work, and using this knowledge to create a working toy.

Jigsaw
