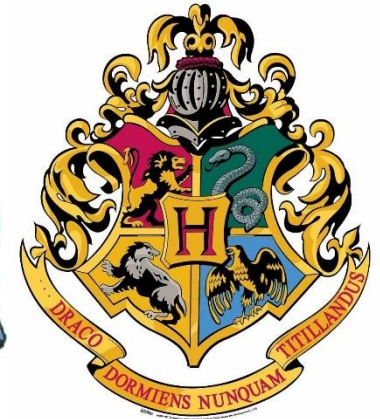
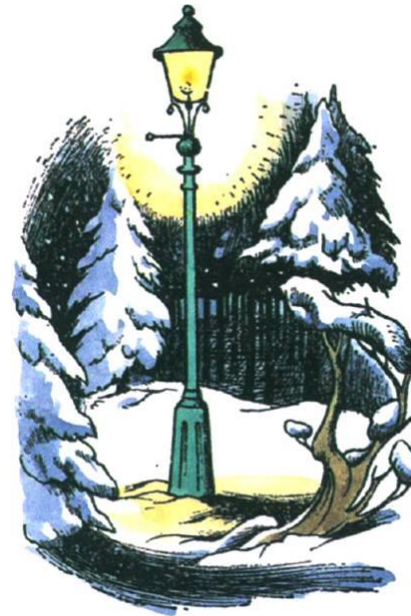
Here are some great books you could read from the DRET reading spine.

A fantastic full term for Year 4! We are very proud of their attendance and Perfect Purple scores! Keep it up!

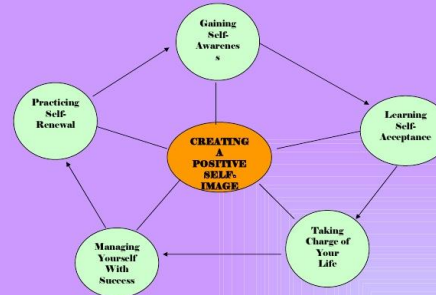
Effective Maths
